Use Cirrus to Enable Researchers at Other Institutions to

Access REDCap!

What is REDCap?

REDCap is a secure web application for building and managing online surveys and databases and commonly used by researchers. Researchers from many institutions, especially if there is a shared grant or collaboration, require access to REDCap.

How Does Cirrus Help?

Cirrus has been working with Children's Hospital of Philadelphia and the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill to deploy the Cirrus Proxy to enable access to REDCap for collaborators at other InCommon institutions. This allows those collaborators to use their own institution's username and password for access. It also eliminates the need to set up separate accounts for researchers which streamlines access, maintains secure access for critical systems and greatly reduces the support burden from forgotten usernames and/or passwords!

FedCM Contributions! Why is Higher Ed concerned about FedCM?

supporting federated authentication without reliance on technologies being phased out, such as third-party cookies.

The Federated Credential Management API (or FedCM) is an emerging standard for

FedCM aims to ensure continued support for "sign in with <your organization>" authentication through mediated browser dialogues, but current functionality does not address patterns unique and common to higher education, such as multilateral federation.

What is Being Done? Heather Flanagan, from Spherical Cow Consulting, gave a presentation on

significant upcoming changes to browser support that garnered significant attention at the Internet2 Technology Exchange in December, leading to a dedicated meeting with subject matter experts from major browser providers and R&E federation technologies this February. Mary McKee and Gary Windham represented Cirrus Identity at the February

meeting, where the group developed two proposals for adapting FedCM to accommodate multilateral federations such as InCommon. Upcoming meetings will also include Cirrus CTO Patrick Radke, and Director of Product, Mark Rank. Interested in learning more or getting involved? Check out the W3C Community

Verified Credential Proof of Concept with Microsoft Entra Verified Credentials and SimpleSAMLphp Verified Credentials stored via user "wallets" on smartphones offer the promise of

greater user control when releasing data. Most campuses have implemented SSO via the SAML protocol, with some OIDC and CAS as well. Until applications are able to integrate directly with Verified Credential user verification flows,, campuses may wish to allow students, faculty and staff to use wallet-based identifiers to access SAML, OIDC, or CAS-protected applications. Cirrus Identity developed a new authentication module in SimpleSAMLphp to

enable users to verify their identity using a Microsoft Entra Verified ID, and then convert that into a SAML authentication response. We then implemented a Proof of Concept workflow to demonstrate this application of Verified Credentials to "authenticate" to an application via SAML. See: Full Demo
